





Example #1 – Workload Data




Why is this data important?

Example #2 – User Population




Why is this data important?

User pop is used in funding allocation formulas, to calculate per capita expenditure amounts, facilities planning, budget justifications and more.

Why are 3rd party collections important?

- Provides additional funding resources to allow facilities to maintain accreditation and expand access to care.
- Adds an additional 25% to appropriated funding.
- Funds 42% of total FTEs.
