What is a virtual benefits fair?

An online event where attendees can connect through robust chat tools, webinars, immersive booths, and endlessly valuable content. A virtual benefits fair is a way for us to bring an event to you at the tips of your fingers, on your device, at your convenience.

Who can attend the event?

This event is open to all postal employees and retirees.

Is the event on-the-clock or off-the-clock?

This event is off-the-clock during non-working hours.

How much will it cost me to attend this event?

Nothing. There is no cost.

Where will the event be held?

This is an online event. You do not have to travel to any specific location. You can participate anywhere that you have Internet access. The event is accessible from desktop, mobile and tablet devices.

Do I need to register for this event?
