# Improving Nursing Home Resident COVID-19 Vaccination Rates

In response to the Biden Administration COVID-19 Winter Preparedness Plan, in January 2023 Health Quality Innovators (HQI) launched the Take Aim at a Healthy New Year campaign to improve vaccination rates among nursing home residents.

During this QIN-QIO six-week sprint, HQI increased the ability for nursing homes to deliver COVID-19 boosters by providing ombudsman programs in its four-state service area with informational packages designed for hesitant residents and families. HQI also expanded partnerships with Community Pharmacy Enhanced Services Network pharmacies and health departments to provide onsite vaccine clinics.

In addition, HQI partnered with the American Society for Consultant Pharmacists (ASCP) to offer a webinar on enhancing pharmacy partnerships and vaccine administration. The session featured representatives from a nursing home and long-term care pharmacy who shared strategies to increase resident booster rates. ASCP promoted the event to their membership and HQI shared the invitation with other QIN-QIOs. Representatives from 47 states, Puerto Rico and Canada attended the event.

## **Letter to Nursing Facility Staff:**

Thank you for all you do year-round to assist older adults and improve their lives. The Health Quality Innovation Network (HQIN) is pleased to partner with you on an initiative to improve vaccination rates among our most vulnerable populations.




