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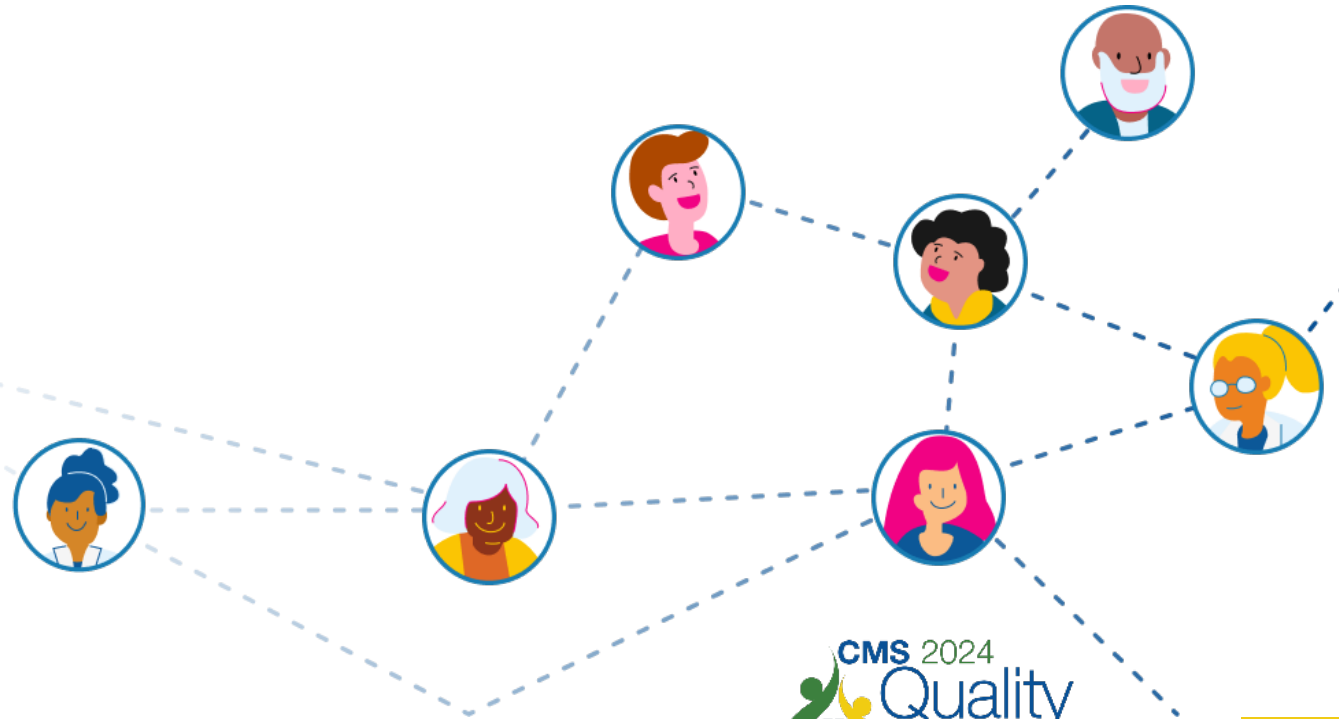

Mission

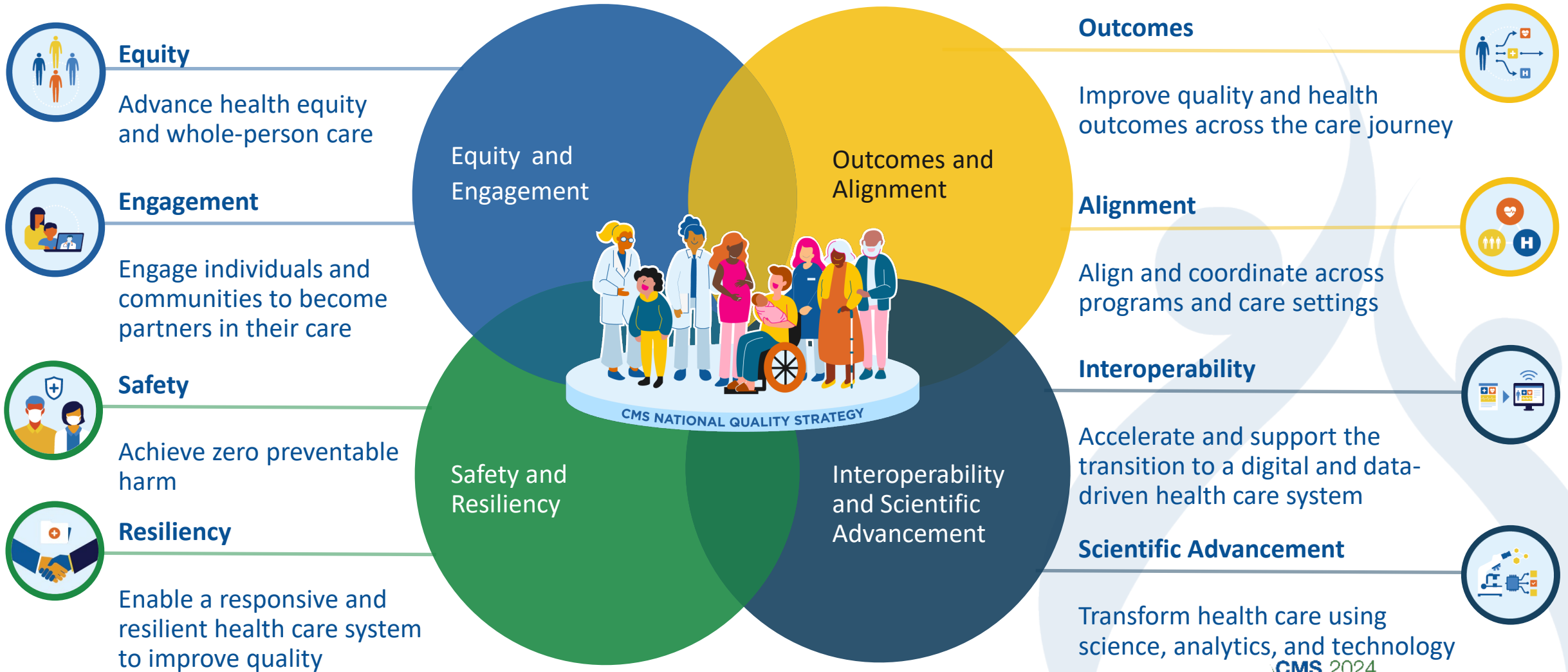
To achieve optimal health and well-being for all individuals.

CMS, a trusted partner, is shaping a resilient, high-value American health care system that delivers high-quality, safe, and equitable care for all.

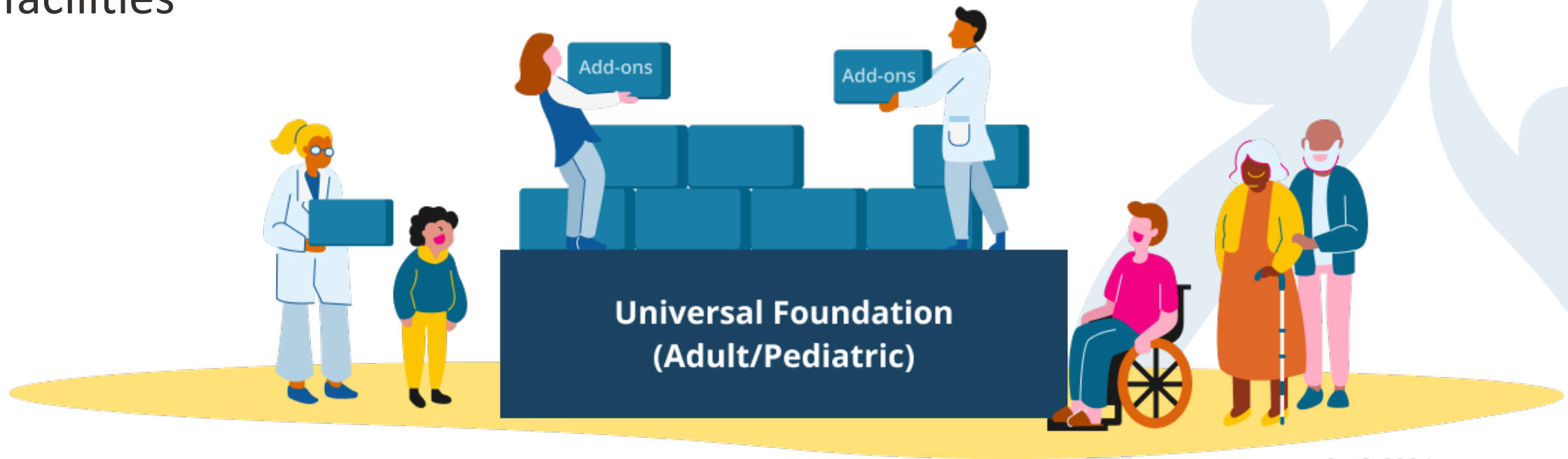


CMS National Quality Strategy Goals



Streamlining the CMS Quality Measurement Portfolio

- Finalized the Adult and Pediatric Universal Foundation measure sets, along with add-on sets for maternity care, hospitals, and the post-acute care facilities



Advancing Health Equity

- Increased number of equity-focused measures across CMS programs
- Provided more confidential feedback reporting to measured entities
- Implemented [Rewarding Excellence for Underserved Populations \(REUP\)](#) across multiple programs
- Continued discussions on standard approach to data collection and stratification approaches
- Mandated stratification of [Medicaid & CHIP Core Set measures](#)
- Advanced Medicaid & CHIP data imputation and publication of equity [data briefs](#)

Addressing Maternal Morbidity and Mortality

- Released [‘Birthing-Friendly’ designation](#)
- Began data reporting for the [Severe Obstetric Complications \(eCQM\)](#) measure in Hospital Inpatient Quality Reporting (HIQR) Program
- Provided resources through the [Improving Postpartum Care Learning Collaborative](#) and [the toolkit on Increasing Access, Quality, and Equity in Postpartum Care in Medicaid & CHIP](#)
- Announced Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) for the new [Transforming Maternal Health \(TMaH\)](#) Model for state Medicaid agencies
- Announced 2024 [CMS Medicaid & CHIP Maternal and Infant Health Initiative \(MIHI\) Learning Collaboratives](#) for:
 - Maternal Mental Health and Substance Use Disorder
 - Maternal Hypertension and Cardiovascular Health
