

Behavioral Health (BH) Quality Measures: A CMS Measures Inventory Tool (CMIT) Search Use Case



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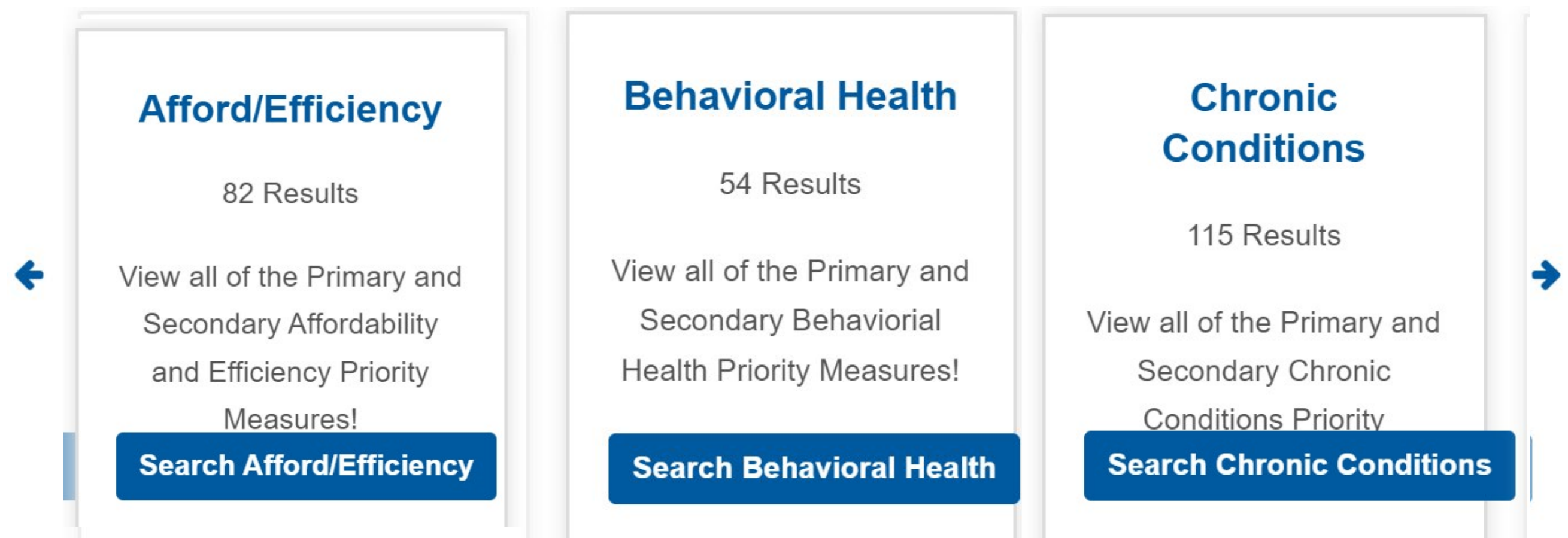
The CMS Measures Inventory Tool (CMIT) is the repository of record for information about the measures which CMS uses to promote healthcare quality and quality improvement. CMIT includes measure info details across 26 quality reporting programs, CMMI models, and Medicaid. CMIT does not contain measure performance data, which is available on various CMS public reporting websites.

Summary of BH Measures in CMIT



53 BH measures spanning 23 Medicare programs, Marketplace, Medicaid, and 1 CMMI model.



25 measures related to mental health screening and treatment



12 measures related to substance use prevention and treatment



10 measures related to opioid use prevention and treatment



3 measures related to suicide prevention and 4 measures for integrated health

- Our **vision** is for all the people we serve to get access to person-centered, timely, and affordable care.
- The **CMS Behavioral Health Strategy** focuses on three key areas: 1) substance use disorders prevention, treatment, and recovery services, 2) ensuring effective pain treatment and management, and 3) improving mental health care and services.
- CMS uses CMIT to assess where there are measurement gaps and to facilitate enhancing completeness in assessing quality across all BH conditions.
