Who is DLA?

- DLA manages the global supply chain as the Nation's Combat Logistics Support Agency
- DLA procures specific supplies centrally, then distributes them to the workforce and/or the warfighter
- We support:
 - The Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, Space Force, Coast Guard
 - 10 Combatant Commands
 - Other Federal Agencies and
 - Partner and Allied Nations
- We also:
 - Supply 86% of the military's spare parts
 - Supply nearly 100% of fuel and troop support consumables
 - Manage the reutilization of military equipment
 - Offer document automation and production services to a host of military and federal agencies



DLA Aviation

- DLA's combat logistics and aviation demand and supply chain
- Primary mission is to procure repair parts for fixed-wing and rotary-wing aircraft, bottled gases and cylinders, and oversee DLA's green products initiative to harness and recycle elements that would be hazardous to the environment
- Manages the Department of Defense (DoD) map repository of aeronautical, digital, hydrographic and topographic map products
- Operates the federal government's only industrial plant equipment facility which provides a full range of maintenance services

DLA Contracting Services Office (DCSO)

- Manages DLA enterprise-wide requirements including:
 - Major Information Technology (IT) systems and programs
 - IT products and services
 - Business and facilities services
 - Other enterprise services for DLA
- DoD's provider of document services including:
 - Conversion
 - Digital warehousing
 - Printing, duplicating, distributing, and copier management
- Responsible for acquiring, upgrading, rotating and disposing of stockpile materials

DLA Distribution

- Manages DLA's network of distribution depots responsible for the receipt, storage, issue, packing, preservation and transportation of DLA-managed items
- Purchases supplies and services in support of their mission and buy items such as:
 - Packing materials
 - Conveyor systems
 - Other services to support the DoD distribution network

DLA Energy

- Manages petroleum products including:
 - Jet fuels
 - Aviation and automotive gasoline
 - Marine diesel
 - Heating oil and lubricants
 - Alternative fuels
 - Coal, natural gas, and electricity
- Supports utilities at DoD installations to include:
 - Electricity
 - Natural gas
 - Water and wastewater systems
- Manages the government fuel card program

DLA Land and Maritime

- Manages consumable repair parts and depot-level repairable procurement operations for nearly 2,000 land-based and maritime weapon systems
- Manages parts for land vehicle operations including:
 - Maintenance kits
 - Transmission, engine and suspension components
 - Tires and batteries
 - Radios and parts for small arms
- Maritime supply chain procures repair parts for the nation's ships to include:
 - Electrical parts
 - Valves
 - Pumps
 - Motors
 - Cabling

Troop Support

- Provides support for humanitarian and disaster relief efforts and warfighter support through supply chains to include:
- **Subsistence** is the sole provider of food for all branches of the military worldwide and supports other non-DoD activities such as the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), the State Department, and the U.S. Agency for International Development
- **Clothing and Textiles** provides clothing, textiles and equipment to service members, other federal agencies and partner nations
- **Medical** supports warfighters and their dependents globally including:
 - Surgical items
 - Preventative vaccines
 - Pharmaceuticals
 - Field hospital equipment
 - Medical supplies for animals

Troop Support continued

- **Construction and Equipment** provides everything from light bulbs to bulldozers, including:
 - Construction and building supplies such as – lumber; metal products such as wire, sheet, plates and bars; paint; lighting and lamps; electrical and plumbing supplies and heating, ventilation and air condition supplies and hardware
 - Fire and emergency equipment such as – marine lifesaving and diving equipment, tactical gear, search and rescue equipment and personal protection gear
 - Manages a variety of storage equipment including – portable buildings, storage tanks, drums, can, bottles, jars and bags
