Delivering Strategic Effects for the Army

- **AMC's SAE continues to develop/execute the vast majority of Army materiel SA programs**
- **Team of highly trained professionals synchronizing and integrating Army SAE efforts to deliver those effects...**
- **Networked for action with USASAC (Fwd) SMEs in the Combatant Commands and the Army Service Component Commands**
- **Executing 44 Combatant Command and Regional FMS priority cases**
- **Integrating Army divestiture as means to Build Partner Capacity**
- **Established, enduring relationships with allies and partners around the world**
- **28 SA Training Teams currently in 19 countries and projected in 15 additional countries**

On-Going Security Cooperation Reform Efforts



HFAC Technical, Industrial, & Governmental Engagement Readiness (TIGER) Task Force

- *Modernize the government's process for selling arms overseas*
- *Assemble experts, hold briefings, and issue recommendations for potential legislation*
- *Examine where Congress needs to cut bureaucracy & where industry needs to invest in addressing bottlenecks*



Department of State 10-Point Action Plan to Re-Tool Oversight of FMS

- *Strategic Planning for FMS – developing a regional approach to arms transfers with prioritization of cases*
- *Improving FMS Adjudication – modernizing the Congressional Notification process and improving SCO training*
- *Forward-Looking FMS Support – streamlining internal processes to avoid delivery delays*



OSD / DSCA Continuous Process Improvement (CPI) Board

- *Follow-on effort from SecDef's FMS Tiger Team – working 85 action items*
- *Army is OPR for 6 actions and OCR for 44 actions – covers 7 areas for improvement*
- *Strategic prioritization; FMS administration; Non-Program of Record; Tech Security and Exportability; Foreign Disclosure; DIB Capacity and Contracting; Workforce Development*

Army Security Assistance Enterprise (ASAE) Reform Efforts

- *Under Secretary of the Army effort with ASA (ALT) to recommend improvements to SA operations*
- *Streamline the process to make more responsive to changing global requirements*
- *5 LOEs – Strategy; Army Regulation, Policies, Processes, and Governance; Security Assistance Business Processes and Data Analytics; Tech Security/Foreign Disclosure; Workforce Development*
