






Indian Self-Determination & Education Assistance Act (ISDEAA) – 1975

Tribal Self-Governance Amendments of 2000 (Title V)

Indian Health Care Improvement Act (IHCIA) – Reauthorized in 2010

## **Eligibility Requirements**

- 1. Completion of a Planning Phase.
- 2. Tribal Resolution Formally Requesting Participation.
- 3. Three- Year Record of Financial Stability
