- When: During cruise ship arrivals in Suva.
- What: A tailored program designed to immerse guests in our community's way of life.
- Guest Engagement:
 - Cultural Immersion: Learn about traditional
 Fijian community life. Herbal medicine walk etc.
 - *Entertainment*: Enjoy vibrant cultural performances by village members.
 - **Refreshment:** A taste of local hospitality with light refreshments.
- **Duration:** Each visit is approximately 1 hour and 30 minutes, offering a concentrated yet enriching experience.

25 YEARS OF IMPACT: COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE

Cruise Tourism: A Catalyst for Development:

 The revenue generated from cruise tourism over the past 25 years has been instrumental in funding significant village projects.

Key Infrastructure Projects:

 Village Church: Estimated cost FJD 450,000. A central place of worship and prayer. Also act as an evacuation centre during any major natural disaster.



25 YEARS OF IMPACT: COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE

- Community Hall: Estimated cost FJD 150,000. A
 versatile space for community gatherings and
 events. Including hosting day guest during cruise
 day.
- *Improved Footpaths*: Enhancing accessibility and safety throughout the village.
- These projects have significantly improved the quality of life for all Sawani residents.

Beyond Infrastructure: Nurturing Our Community and Environment:

- Supporting Village Ceremonies: Funds contribute to essential community works, traditional ceremonies, and funerals, upholding our cultural heritage.
- Investing in Education: Direct support for children's education, empowering the next generation of Sawani leaders.
- Environmental Stewardship:
 - Riverbank Tree Planting: A vital initiative to combat soil erosion along the riverbanks, protecting our natural resources.

ADDRESSING GROWTH: THE NEED FOR A DEDICATED SUMMER HOUSE


A Growing Challenge:

- Our current Community Hall, while valuable, can only accommodate 60 guests in one sitting.
- Capacity Constraints: With increasing cruise visitor numbers, we frequently resort to setting up temporary tents outside the hall to accommodate the overflow.
- This impacts the guest experience and operational efficiency.
- *The Solution*: A dedicated facility designed specifically for our cruise tourism visitors.

THE SAWANI SUMMER HOUSE PROJECT

Our Next Chapter in Sustainable Tourism:

- **Vision:** To construct a purpose-built "Summer House" dedicated exclusively to cruise tourism day visits.
- **Purpose:** To provide a comfortable, spacious, and culturally appropriate venue for our growing number of visitors.
- Estimated Budget: FJD 400,000.
- This project represents our commitment to enhancing the visitor experience and ensuring the continued sustainability of our program.
