Pioneering Electric Flight: The ePlane Project

- 2019: World's first airline to fly an all-electric commercial aircraft
- Significant research & development into certifying & commercializing battery-powered propulsion
- Leading the transition to sustainable, zero-emission regional aviation

Moving Beyond Carbon Neutrality: From Offsetting to Insetting

- 2007: The world's first fully carbon-neutral airline through third-party carbon offsetting
- 2024: Transitioned to an insetting model focused on direct investment in our ePlane program, targeting operational aviation fuel-related emissions
 - Insetting = investing within our own value chain, aligning with the International Insetting Platform and World Economic Forum definitions
 - A portion of each flight, now contributes to ePlane research & development, based on an estimate of the traveller's carbon footprint
- What's Still Offset: Harbour Air continues to purchase premium carbon offsets for its corporate footprint (facilities, electricity, and other fuels)
- **Impact:** Ensures sustainability efforts drive real, long-term progress toward zero-emission aviation, beyond symbolic carbon neutrality
