It was clear that the short- and long-term effects were going to be devastating.

In response, Inspiring Service, a Multiplying Good and Independent Sector award winner, identified and

acquired rights to the most proven, secure, and scalable virtual technology being utilized anywhere in the education segment. And then, Inspiring Service invested hundreds of thousands of dollars to make it better and meet the variety of needs facing organizations, schools and communities.

Inspiring Service is now ready to provide the tool to up to 10 qualified organizations at no cost to ensure that ALL students have access to academic support -- when they need it. The initial phase of applications is intended to support 5th-12th grade math help, but any disciplines can use the platform.

After a successful pilot last summer and implementations in public schools in Cincinnati in 2020-21 and Boston in 2021, Inspiring Service is offering the platform to organizations and communities who can use it to re-engage sidelined and under-utilized volunteers and provide students with an online tool facilitating 1:1 free help.

When the coronavirus pandemic struck the U.S. in March 2020 and schools all across the country closed and transitioned to "learn-from-home," Inspiring Service knew

disadvantaged families would be harmed further by not having access to existing expensive online help platforms. As was expected, the capacity of existing free tools quickly evaporated.

Called StudyHall, this new online tutoring program offers free, on demand, 1:1 tutoring with qualified and approved helpers in a safe and secure environment. Helpers support learners through concepts and problems from simple to complex. No matter their level study, students will find the help they need. This one-of-a-kind program was developed to ensure all students have access to homework help when they need it.

- Qualified and approved homework helpers are available on demand.
- Voice and text chat options offer communication flexibility.
- The platform is anonymous for students and secure.
- There is an interactive white board for problem-solving and classroom demonstrations.
- The platform can be used on phones, tablets, or computers.
