Guidelines for submission of posters

Technical Guidelines:

An abstract on the research contributions containing the following aspects:

- o Title of project
- o Authors and affiliation(s)
- o Funding agency (if the research project is funded)
- o Background
- o Objectives
- o Methodology
- o Main findings/Results
- o Recommendations

Technical Guidelines:

Final posters must be in A0 format (118.9 cm x 84.1 cm). Posters can be written in English or Arabic. Posters should be eye-catching, attractive, presents sufficient information and easy to read.

- o Heading should contain a title, author(s), and author affiliations.
- o Keep at least a 1-inch margin on all sides.
- o Paragraphs should be no longer than 10-20 lines.

Submission details

Please submit your poster(s) by email, using the subject: Call for posters to DIFI, by 12 February 2021. Finalists will be informed of their selection on 15 February 2021 and are to be read. All posters selected for presentation will be required to submit a finalized version of their poster, in PDF format, by 11 February 2021.

By submitting a poster to this call, applicants agree to the publication of their poster on the conference virtual platform and website, should their poster be selected.
