Privacy Act Statement (5 U.S.C. § 552a, as amended):

Authority: Information solicited for the Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) Career Symposium Registration is authorized by the 2018 FAA Reauthorization Act, Title VI, Public Law 94-353, and Public Law 101-610, Section 182.

Purpose: Students, parents or educators who wish to attend the STEM Career Symposium provide their name, email address, grade and type of school they attend. For children under the age of 13, the parent/legal guardian provides their information and not the child's. The parent/guardian will also be required to sign a Children Online Privacy Protection Act form prior to their child participation in the STEM Career Symposium. The information is used to create a user accounts for access to the Symposium.

Routine Uses: In accordance with the Privacy Act system of records notice, <u>DOT/ALL 13 -</u> <u>Internet/Intranet Activity and Access Records</u>, this information is routinely used;:

- To provide information to any person(s) authorized to assist in an approved investigation of improper access or usage of DOT computer systems;
- To an actual or potential party or his or her authorized representative for the purpose of negotiation or discussion of such matters as settlement of the case or matter, or informal discovery proceedings;
- To other government agencies where required by law.
