Notice to Parents

In compliance with the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act of 1998 (COPPA), 15 U.S.C. §§ 6501-6506 (2001), parents or legal guardians of children under 13 years of age must provide consent to the collection, use, or disclosure of the personal information of their children collected through Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) websites and other online services.

Your permission is required for the FAA to collect, use, or disclose your child's personal information. Your child will not be permitted to participate in activities requiring collection of information through our websites and online services without your permission.

For each student to participate in the Aviation Safety (AVS) STEM Career Symposium, the FAA will collect and maintain the minimum amount of information necessary to register students and ensure they can participate in all activities.

The information you submitted using the registration form for the AVS STEM Career Symposium (your name and email address, and the student's name and email address) will be used to register each student for the AVS STEM Career Symposium and to generate an account to access the virtual platform utilized by FAA for the event. Within the virtual platform, the FAA will collect the following information from the student: 1) Name; and 2) Email address

Students will also be able to use chat messaging functions within the virtual platform. Content that students post in these chats will remain on the virtual platform utilized by FAA, and will not be made available to the public. Only authorized FAA personnel and the participants in the AVS STEM Career Symposium will be able to view information the student provides within the site's chat function.

The information that the FAA collects about students for purposes of the AVS STEM Career Symposium will be used for internal FAA purposes only, and will not be disclosed to the public or to unauthorized individuals within the FAA unless required by law or Court order.

Once collected, you will retain the right to review your child's information and request deletion of information. Upon a request for deletion, the FAA will delete the information or ensure that the information is no longer retrievable by the child's unique identifier. To request review of your child's records or to revoke your consent, you may contact the AVS STEM Program Team at <u>9-AVS-STEMProgram@faa.gov</u>. After collection, this information will be maintained by the FAA for ninety days (unless subject to a request for deletion), and thereafter will be destroyed in accordance with the FAA's federal recordkeeping requirements.
