

Policy for Supporting Breastfeeding Patrons

In recognition of the well documented health advantages of breastfeeding for infants and mothers, [name of festival] provides a supportive environment to enable breastfeeding attendees to express their milk during festival/event hours.

[Name of festival/event] subscribes to the following festival support policy. This policy will be available to festival/event organizers as well as attendees.

Festival/Event Responsibilities

Breastfeeding mothers who choose to provide their milk for their infants during the festival/event shall receive:

1. A Place to Express Milk

A private room (not a toilet stall or restroom) shall be available for mothers to breastfeed or express milk.

2. The room will:

- be private and sanitary
- have a comfortable chair
- preferably located near a sink with running water for washing hands and rinsing out breast pump parts
- and have an electrical outlet
- changing table if available
- fan (during summer festivals)

Act 680

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-14-112, concerning indecent exposure, is amended to read as follows:

•A woman is not in violation of this section for breastfeeding a child in a public place or any place where other individuals are present.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 20, Chapter 27 is amended to add an additional subchapter to read as follows:

•20-27-2001. Breastfeeding in public. A woman may breastfeed a child in a public place or any place where other individuals are present.
