Let's Grow STEAMx Hosts the Probe College Fair

Probe is an annual program of college fairs and guidance counselor workshops that are held throughout the state of Georgia. The program is managed by the Georgia Education Articulation Committee (GEAC), whose sole mission is to disseminate information and stimulate interest in post-secondary education for students in Georgia. Approximately 50 colleges will be available in-person to speak with regional high school students during YCCExpo.






Resources & Access
