



Our care calls are anywhere from an hour up to twenty-four-hour care. We look after those who have Dementia, Complex Care, Challenging Behaviour, End of Life, Companionship etc.

Our ethos really stands out to our Service Users, and this has proven to stop hospitalisation of some Service Users because the staff are aware of their needs, their routine and if there is anything 'out of the blue' these are picked up and address immediately.

Our Staff enjoy the way of working because they have the opportunity to choose their own hours of when they want to work, they have the flexibility for their own home life and it is reassurance for themselves that they see the same families each day/week to keep up the continuity.


