



# Learn to Navigate the Virtual Career Fair

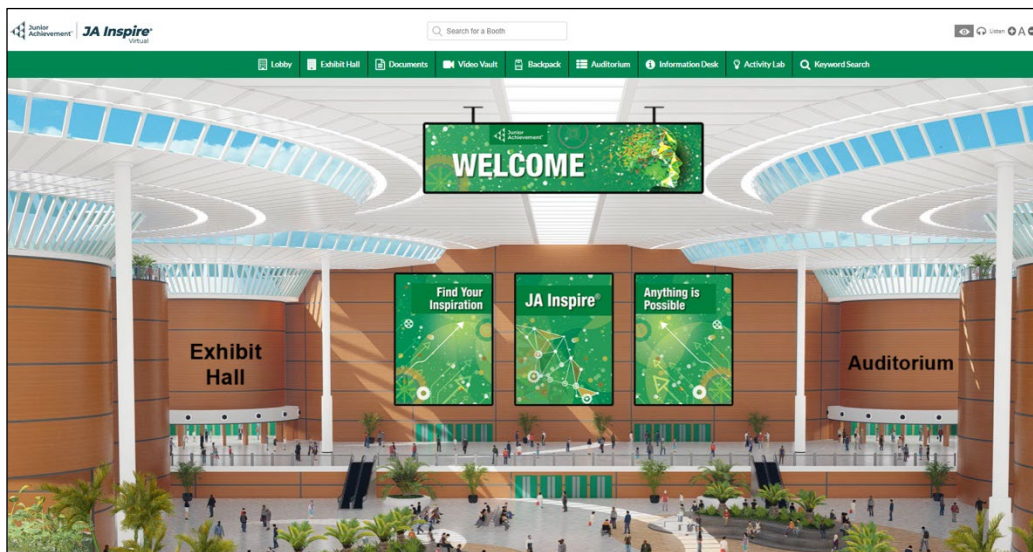
These are the main areas that make up the virtual career fair:

- Lobby
- Information Desk
- Exhibit Hall
- Auditorium
- Activity Lab

Take a few minutes to familiarize yourself with these areas.

## Lobby

The Lobby is where you enter the career fair and access all its resources. Visit the Exhibit Hall to learn about local businesses and jobs in each career cluster. Attend speeches and webinars in the Auditorium. Get help at the Information Desk. Use the navigation bar to explore further.



## Information Desk

How do you get help finding your way around the event? Go to the Information Desk. There you can:

1. Learn how to navigate and use the features of the event.
2. Get technical help.
3. Find listings of exhibitor booths organized by career cluster.
4. Find listings of speakers and webinars.



## Exhibit Hall

Enter the Exhibit Hall to explore local companies' booths and learn more about the 16 career clusters.

- Use the Exhibitors Index to locate a specific booth or move left and right to visit booths.
- Visit the career cluster booths to learn more about the jobs in each career cluster.
- At each booth, view documents, videos, and links. Some booths have hyperlinks on the booth pictures.

Add information to your backpack and email it to yourself or a parent. You can spend as much time as you want in the fair while it is open. Feel free to share the experience with others, including friends, teachers, and family members.



## Auditorium

Visit the Auditorium to attend webinars or listen to prerecorded speakers. Select the screen to see your choices. You will need your **Learn from the Experts** worksheet to complete the **What I LEARNED** column.
