### MINIMUM MEMBERSHIP CRITERIA\*

#### ALUMNI

- Completed at least 2 years of a full program at a recognized college or university or completed a college degree at a recognized college or university.
- Achieved distinction in his community.
- Successfully complete the Membership Intake Process (MIP).

#### COLLEGIATE

- Attend a recognized college or university pursuing a baccalaureate degree
- Have a 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale at the time of application.
- Successfully complete the Membership Intake Process (MIP).

#### \*NOTE

- Candidates cannot hold active or previous membership in another intercollegiate fraternity, other than an honorary or professional fraternity.
- Candidates must apply to a chapter in the region where they reside.
- Chapters may add additional criteria that does not conflict with constitutional criteria
