

# Delta Authors on Tour 2021-2022 VIRTUAL STOPS How This Works

This season, we are excited to again have you virtually shop online with us! We thank you in advance for perusing through this exciting document with our featured authors' books! Here's how it will work:

- 1. On all flyers, each chapter has listed an event registration link. Please make sure to sign up early as some stops may be limited!
- 2. Thirty days prior to a tour stop, each chapter will release a DAOT Order Guide highlighting each author invited to their Region. Featured authors have provided two methods of virtual payment and this document will be used for patrons to purchase the highlighted works of these exceptional authors.
- 3. Prior to each stop, a link will be sent to the registered attendees by the Host Chapter.
- 4. The DAOT events are hosted on virtual online platforms such as Zoom or Hopin and are scheduled to last 2 hours. This format allows each author to speak about her fascinating book(s) and includes individual Breakout room sessions where you will have an opportunity to directly engage authors who've particularly piqued your interest. During the event, Patrons will also be able to virtually order books directly from the author. All purchases will be shipped to you, free of charge.
- 5. In order to best facilitate the s&H process, all books will be autographed, not personalized. If you'd like to order more books, simply repeat the process.
- 6. The last day you may purchase books will be midnight in your time zone i.e., 12 p.m. EST, CST, PST, etc.. If books are not received two weeks after the tour stop, PLEASE let the chapter know at the email address on the title page.








## THE PENALTY FOR SUCCESS:

My Father Was Lynched in Lowndes County, Alabama

Just weeks before Christmas, 1947, Josephine Bolling was five years old and learned that her father, Elmore Bolling, just 39 and the father of seven was dead. Elmore Bolling was a leader in Lowndes County's black community, had established himself as a man who volunteered to serve the less fortunate and had worked hard to build a small trucking business and provide for his family and others.

In this moving and important book, The Penalty for Success: My Father Was Lynched In Lowndes County, Alabama, the author tells the story of the murder of a black man in 1940s Lowndes County, Alabama. It is a story that reveals the scheme to cover up a "lynching". Josephine Bolling McCall's story of her father's murder presents convincing evidence that he was lynched, although he was not hanged, mutilated, or burned before a crowd of people. Elmore Bolling was shot six times in the front of his body with a pistol and once in the back with a shotgun. After years of research, including interviews with relatives and elderly Lowndes County residents, Josephine Bolling McCall sought and found answers to many troubling questions that she had about her family, especially about events in her father's life. Her journey of discovery presents a revealing narrative of time, a place, and people that challenge us to rethink the reality of life for both blacks and whites in a rural, southern community.





#### JOSEPHINE BOLLING MCCALL, AUTHOR

Josephine Bolling McCall is an Alabama-based speaker, author, and educator who addresses America's overlooked history of lynching and the racial caste system that made it possible. As one of the few children of a Jim Crow South lynching victim speaking today, Jo is a primary source for this period in America's history of racial terror.
