## **6 Steps for Capturing Leadership Support**

## Critical Questions for Discussion

## **Step 1: Establishing Common Ground**

The first step in the process of capturing leadership support is to establish common ground.
» What kind of results do our Church leaders want to see from a health ministry? (engagement, visitors, smal groups, Bible studies, baptisms, etc.)
» How do those desired results shape the way we do health ministry?
» How are we doing in giving our leaders the evidence they want to see?
» What are the most important outcomes we can share with our leaders? List three:
Step 2: Connecting Emotionally
The second step in effectively engaging our leadership in healthy ministry is to connect emotionally.
» What kind of personal stories of health ministry already exist within our local Church or extended Church family?
» How might we best tell them to our leadership?
Step 3: Making It Personal
The third step in engaging our leadership in supporting the church's health ministry is to make it personal.
» How are our Church leaders doing with respect to their overall health status?
» Is there a champion for personal health among our leadership team?

» what resources might we leverage to help our leaders protect their health and become healthler?
Step 4: Supplying the Evidence
The fourth step in engaging our leadership in supporting health ministry is to supply as much evidence about the success of other health ministries as we can.
» What resources already exist to help us do this?
» What other churches in the world have flourishing health ministry programs?
» Are there churches in our area that have built effective health ministries that would capture the attention of our leaders?
» How can this information be leveraged to our advantage?
Step 5: Connecting the Dots
The fifth step in supporting our health ministries is to help leadership better understand the specific steps to implementing a health ministry.
» Why is it important for our church leaders to understand the specific steps of implementing a health ministry?
» How can we involve our church leaders in the health ministry strategic planning process?
Step 6: Building Skills
The final step in capturing leadership support is helping our leaders build the skills necessary to effectively lead to church's health ministries.
» How can we help our leaders be more vocal when it comes to health ministries?
» How can we help our leaders be more visible when it comes to health ministries?
