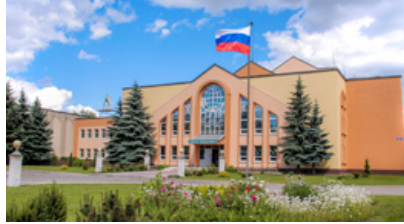

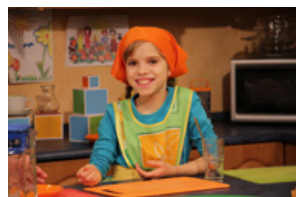

We reach 3,610 cities, both large and small in Russia, but that number is likely higher, since our satellite signal is open to everyone!

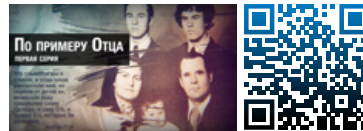
