5-Step Disciple-making Cycle

to bless Buddhists



Step 1: Win Trust

Using Jesus' method of mingling with people, showing genuine sympathy, and helping those in need, begin winning the trust of your unbelieving friends. By taking time to listen, you will begin to sympathize as you understand that they are doing their best to address their own needs, pain, and fears. Pray for God to open their hearts to Jesus. GOAL: Trust.



Step 2: Inspire Faith

Begin by sharing testimonies of how Jesus is blessing you. Then invite them to ask God to reveal Himself to be real and show that He cares about them. Pray *for* them and *with* them. When they experience God's love, they will believe that He is real. Encourage them to share their story with others and teach them how to respond through grateful worship and service to others. GOAL: Faith.



Step 3: Present Gospel

Tell the story of angels attending & heralding Jesus birth. Share of Jesus' compassion, miracles, teachings about the sinful condition of the heart, His offer to heal the heart, His silent suffering and cruel death, and His power to raise back to life. Share His plan to destroy suffering, sin and death and recreate the heavens and earth. Those who accept him as their God will experience heart healing, transformation, and will be welcomed into the new world. Invite them to accept Jesus' way for their life and commit to learning how to follow Him. ★**Dedicate** them to Jesus as baby believers and welcome them into Sabbath School or care group membership. GOAL: Repentance.



Step 4: Teach Believer

Beginning with Creation and fall, trace the story of redemption through the Bible. Include the rebellion of Israel, Jesus as fulfilled prophesy, warnings of Christian apostasy, three angels' messages, the 2nd coming, destruction of the wicked, and the earth made new. Next, review topics related to faithful living with God today. Include how to study Scripture, pray, and confess sins one to another. Assess your disciples' obedience to the Word of God. ★**Baptize** them as Seventh-day Adventist members. GOAL: Obedience.



Step 5: Coach Discipler

Help your disciple identify their spiritual gifts for sharing Jesus' love and hastening His return. Coach them through the steps of making disciples. Identify God's specific calling for them. ★**Commission** your disciple by laying on hands and praying for God to use them for the specific service God has called them. GOAL: Mission.

Assessment: Disciple Trusts Me

My disciple...

- Considers me to be their friend.
- Initiates making contact with me to talk or spend time together.
- Confides in me regarding problems he/she is facing.
- Knows and accepts that I am a follower of Jesus.

Assessment: Disciple Has Faith in God

My disciple...

- Admires my religion and/or my testimony about how God helps me.
- Has a story about God revealing Himself somehow to them.
- Knows God is real and is asking questions to learn more about God.
- Expresses their desire to pray to God and honor Him in their life.

Assessment: Disciple Has Turned to Follow Jesus

My disciple...

- Accepts that Jesus was a historical person who performed miracles, lived a holy life, and taught good morals.
- Recognizes that evil begins in the heart and that Jesus can heal their heart.
- Expresses desire to be ready for Jesus' return when He will destroy this world of suffering, sin, and death and will welcome His transformed followers into the new earth.
- Joins with believers in worship, has decided to study the Bible to learn how to follow Jesus, and has been ★**dedicated** as a baby believer & member of a Sabbath School class or care group.

Assessment: Disciple is Obeying Jesus & His Word

My disciple...

- Accepts the Bible as true history and as God's authority in their life.
- Recognizes that Satan and his angels seek to deceive and destroy us and that our faith and obedience will be tested in these last days.
- Is being transformed through obedience to God through daily devotions, and is keeping Sabbath, tithing, observing health laws, and nurturing other believers.
- Has been ★**baptized** and is sharing their testimony with others.

Assessment: Disciple is Making New Disciples

My disciple...

- Understands the "Disciple-making Cycle" and how to use their talents for God.
- Has led at least two people to faith in God (step 2).
- Has been ★**commissioned** for mission in answer to God's specific calling.
- Has discipled people in turning to Jesus & understanding how to follow Him.
