Doctor of Philosophy in Biology

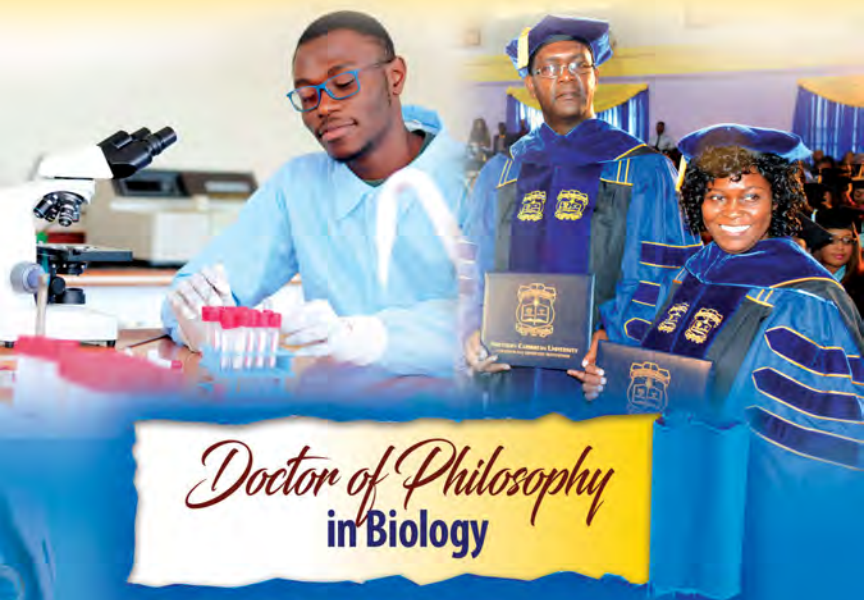


- The Doctor of Philosophy in Biology is an academic degree that provides students with advanced training in the Biological Sciences.

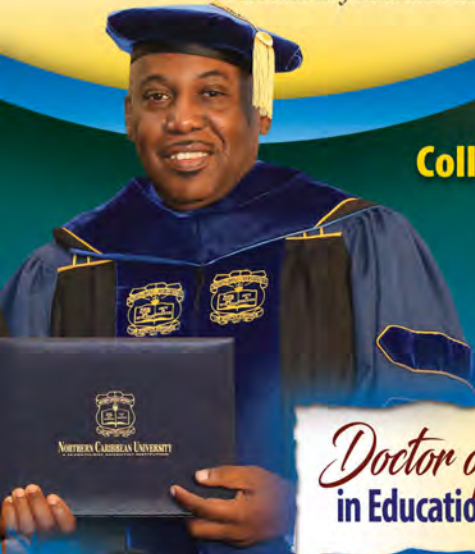
