

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


#### **Food System**

The interconnected set of actors and activities

involved in the production, aggregation, processing, distribution, consumption and disposal of food products,

as well as the **broader** economic, environmental and societal **context** that is **coherently organized** with the overall **function/ purpose** to provide food and nutrition security for all people.



Food System that does not compromise the economic, environmental and societal bases for providing food now and for future generations.

It is resilient to external shocks in the economic, environmental and societal context.



An SFS approach measures, analyzes and improves the economic, environmental and social impacts of activities and interventions in the food system.

First: Analyze and understand the Food System




