

- <u>Unit administrator</u> ordered mannikins and associated supplies

- <u>Unit educators</u> drafted documents for each desired skill
- <u>Transition to Practice</u> <u>team</u> – provided feedback on document drafts
- Simulation specialists suggested edits, formatting updates, and approved for use in education
- Preceptors provided feedback on document usability
- <u>Preceptor Coaches</u> piloted documents with other preceptors
