User Agreement

1. Registration:

you submit for backups, archiving, prevention of fraud and abuse, analytics, satisfaction of legal obligations, or where we otherwise reasonably believe that we have a legitimate reason to do so.

- 9.1.6.3. You may decline to share certain Personal Data with us, in which case we may not be able to provide you some of the features and functionality of the Service.

10. Virtual Events:

- 10.1. Use of Logo and Exhibitor Name: Life Science Exhibits shall have the limited right to use the Exhibitor's exhibitor name, logo, certain marketing materials provided by the Exhibitor for the sole purpose of promoting, marketing and demonstrating Life Science Exhibits' Virtual Events.  - 10.7.2. By Exhibitor, upon 30 days' written notice to Event Organizer, if Event Organizer has committed a material breach of its obligations under the Agreement, and such breach is not cured within the 30 day notice period.
 - 10.7.3. By Event Organizer, if Exhibitor fails to pay the fees due pursuant to this Agreement within ten days of the date such payment is due, or upon 30 days' written notice to Exhibitor if Exhibitor has committed a material breach of its obligations under the Agreement, and such breach is not cured within the 30 day notice period
- 10.8. Limitation of Liability
 - 10.8.1. In no event will any party be liable for incidental, special or consequential penalties or damages, including lost profits, even if such party has been advised of the possibility of such damages. Exhibitor agrees that any liability of Life Science Exhibits and its licensors for damages arising out of the provision of services or failure to provide services, regardless of the form of action, shall not exceed the fees paid by exhibitor for the particular services involved.
- 10.9. Governing Law, Resolution of Disputes
 - 10.9.1. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Florida without giving effect to conflicts of law.

11. Leaderboard & Gamification:
