Working as a **Health Communications/Communications Specialist**, you may:

- Develop and deliver public health messages and materials about the benefits and risks of medical devices and regulatory policies
- Develop content for new and existing websites
- Lead, conduct, and manage audience research and program evaluation activities for health communication and marketing
- Conduct patient labeling reviews
- Assist in the planning and development of communication and marketing priorities, strategies, and practices for effective communication and marketing directed toward professional and lay audiences, including underserved populations and populations at risk

To be considered for the **Health Communications/Communications Specialist** role, here are the skills and experience we're looking for:

- Expertise in public relations and/or health communication/communication and marketing principles, methods, theories, practices, and techniques
- Ability to plan, implement, manage, and evaluate health communication/communication and marketing programs, projects, and strategies
- Skill in developing motivational and/or educational public health materials and information
- Experience developing messages and materials based on communication and marketing theory and principles; audience research; and that are tailored for diverse audiences

Working as a **Government Information Specialist**, you will leverage your knowledge of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) to:

- Perform legal reviews of requests for the disclosure of information to determine if information is exempt from disclosure under applicable statutes and regulations
- Develop Center responses to requests for information
- Consult with other centers and the Office of Chief Counsel, to arrive at agency consensus on important and sensitive issues regarding information disclosure
- Manage the Center's disclosure activities

- Knowledge of government information management principles and practices

- Educate and inform the regulated medical device and radiation-emitting products industry about FDA regulations, policy, and guidance

- Educate and inform consumers, health care professionals, and patients about medical devices and radiation-emitting products
