DISTANCE (AIRPORT-EVENT VENUE)

The distance from the Moi International Airport, Mombasa to Pride Inn Paradise Beach Resort Convention Centre & Spa in Mombasa, Kenya is 54 minutes (24.5 Km) Via Mombasa Road/A 109 and Old Malindi Road.





BEFORE DEPARTURE FROM YOUR DESTINATION

- A valid passport and Kenya visa are required for all visitors/delegates traveling to Kenya, except for nationals from the countries who may obtain their visas on arrival.
- Visa application is done online via the E Visa website www.evisa.go.ke. Create an account, fill in the visa application form, pay the specified visa fee using Visa/Mastercard
- With effect from 9th May 2023, All travelers arriving into Kenya through any point of entry shall no longer be required to show proof of either COVID-19 vaccination or a pre departure COVID-19 test.
- Persons traveling out of Kenya will be required to abide by the travel, health and COVID-19 related requirements of the destination country.
- Valid Yellow Fever Vaccination a copy of the International Certificate of Vaccination (ICV) for yellow fever is required for entry into Kenya for delegates from Yellow fever endemic Zones.

KENYA AIRWAYS

Delegates arriving on Kenya airways (KQ) flights will have on-board awareness/announcements about the conference.

KENYA AIRPORTS AUTHORITY (KAA) AT JKIA

AFENET will have banners located at the various strategic points at both the international arrivals terminals (1E, 1A) and the local departures terminal 1D.

IMMIGRATION

- AFENET will have an express counter to expedite the check-in process (faster clearance) for the delegates; Look out for the AFENET Banner.
- Delegates will be required to clear with Immigration and claim their luggage before proceeding to domestic departures.
- Delegates are expected to check the list of restrictions and prohibited items from Passenger Declaration F88 available online at https://www.kra.go.ke/images/Customs/Passenger-Terminals-FAQs.pdf



TRANSPORT FROM THE AIRPORT


On arrival at the Moi International Airport, in Mombasa, make your way through the port health, and immigration desks. After the immigration, follow the signs to Baggage Claim to retrieve your baggage. Please carry a printed copy of your invitation to the conference as security and immigration officials may ask to see a copy.

Claim your luggage from Baggage Claim area, and clear with customs. AFENET has organized ground transport to get you from the airport to the respective conference hotels in Mombasa. Please look out for the AFENET Banner and Desk.



LOCAL SIM CARDS

These can be purchased at the airport on arrival. You can also get the local currency at the bureau de change desk at the airport. Visa, Mastercard and MPESA are accepted for payment at the hotels

All delegates are required to register by November 4, 2023. Please note that on-site registration are not advised. All delegates are expected to download the vfair event app at the Google Play Store or IOS stores, open the app and sign in using the email you used to register for the conference. The conference schedule and other relevant details are available on the app.

On Day 1 & 2 (Sunday 5th and Monday 6th) an Information Desk will be located at PrideInn Paradise Entrance Hall to assist the delegates and provide accreditation badges for the AFENET Scientific Conference 2023.

Access to the venue will be restricted to accredited delegates only. Please keep your badges at all times (as also required by hotel security). Badges are personal and non-transferable.




